Laviva is an investment associate at Luge Capital, a venture capital firm focused on early-stage fintech companies and AI solutions applied to financial services. Laviva spends her time sourcing fintech startups, performing due diligence and supporting portfolio companies.

Previously, she was an analyst at Ferst Capital Partners (FCP), a fintech focused investment firm and startup foundry. At FCP, she spent her time helping build portfolio companies and supporting their fundraising processes and operations, bringing new investment opportunities and developing the firm's brand in the startup ecosystem.

Laviva is also a VC advisor for Front Row Ventures and advisor for Holt Accelerator. She was selected to be on the 2017 Global Women in FinTech Powerlist and on Canada's 2019 Top 50 Women in Fintech by Digital Finance Institute.

Born and raised in Dhaka, Bangladesh, Laviva moved to Canada to complete her BCom degree with double majors in Economics and Finance from McGill University. She completed CFA Level 1.

An Internationally recognized Quant and Fintech entrepreneur, Dan is also an Adjunct Professor of Mathematical Finance at the University of Toronto, and was the first Director of the Center for Financial Institutions at the Fields Institute. He has worked with numerous financial institutions around the world, lectures extensively on risk and portfolio management, financial engineering, and Fintech innovation, and has authored numerous research publications and several patents. In 2010, he was inducted a Fellow of the Fields Institute for his "outstanding contributions to the Fields Institute, its programs, and to the Canadian mathematical community".

Dan was the co-founder and CEO of R² Financial Technologies, acquired by S&P Capital IQ in 2012. Prior to this, he was part of the executive team at Algorithmics (acquired by IBM), where he had a successful career over a decade.

Dan holds an M.A.Sc. and Ph.D.in Chemical Engineering from the University of Toronto.
